What Happened & How

September 2009 Minutes – Minutes were approved.

CEC Data Review:

- Mr. Martinez reviewed CSAP data for CEC's proficiency levels and explained the measurement guidelines and also remarked that this data right now is not reflecting the same group of students when it comes to 9th graders.
- CSAP test might change so it is done later in the year so it is more accurate about students' performance
- In SIP, there are goals set up for 9th graders for each year
- SIP info will be compared with CSAP scores and see if we are reflecting goals or if it needs to change
- CEC CSAP scores are at or above proficiency (district level)
- School Performance Framework handouts were distributed to CSC members. They were explained by Mr. Martinez. Since not comparing same groups when data was retrieved, SPF were created by the district for each school
- School meets expectations but it is not considering our part-time students. Mr. Martinez is working with the District to include that data
- Red areas mean that students are not keeping standards as expected
- Gaps in Math/Science not closing between lower level students and upper level students
- Colorado ACT score being disputed
- PSEO enrollment being disputed
- Enrollment data will be reviewed
- Parent surveys will be reviewed

School Improvement Plan 2009/2010:

- CSC group reviewed data. Goals regarding Reading/Math didn't reach target
- 35% proficiency in Math
- Concentrator – students that would be in a third or fourth semester of same career – teachers would help them into achieving concentrator level
- Increase number of students passing Accuplacer – college readiness
- Seniors (12th graders) to do internship – work on proposal for 2010/2011
- Current internship program only have eight students that are currently CEC students who are doing an internship in addition to their career classes
- Parent community – start tracking parent participation in all school activities, show data about parent participation, set their goals in SIP, have a parent line with recordings, parent newsletters, work with some kind of mass text messaging.
- Goal 1 – come up with a new target for Writing and strategies to hit target
- Scores in Writing: 9th graders 52%, 10th graders 48%
- Scores in Math: 9th graders 27%, 10th graders 34%
- Goal 2 – career programs: concentrators set 2010 goal and strategy.

- Goal 3 – work with parent community (as explained previously)
