Middle College High School Program for Full-Time Students

CEC/North Middle Colleges offer high school students an exciting opportunity to earn academic/career credits toward a college associate's degree while completing Denver Public Schools (DPS) graduation requirements. CEC/North Middle Colleges are DPS magnet schools.

What does the CEC stand for? CEC is short for the CAREER EDUCATION CENTER, also known as the FRED N. THOMAS CAREER EDUCATION CENTER. CEC has been a part of Denver Public Schools since its opening in 1976. It has always offered in-depth career exploration to high school students from both DPS and non-DPS high schools.

How do the CEC/North Middle Colleges work? Enrollment in CEC/North Middle College of Denver creates a smooth transition from high school to college. Freshmen and sophomores spend half a day in academics and half a day in career class. As juniors and seniors, students take their academic classes on the CCD campus. If they qualify, they can take up to four college classes per year, allowing them the opportunity to earn up to a year's worth of college credit toward their college degree by the end of senior year.

Who can enroll in the CEC/North Middle Colleges? Full-time enrollment is by application and interview only. Any high school student in the metro Denver area can apply. Students are encouraged to visit the school prior to applying. Call 720-423-6600 to schedule a tour.

How much do CEC/North Middle Colleges cost? Both are tuition-free to students in the DPS service area and to all other students who enroll prior to October 1 each school year.

Can full-time CEC/North Middle College students join high school sports teams or clubs? Students can participate in athletic and other extracurricular activities at their home high schools, as well as join Middle College clubs. For students enrolled at North Middle College, their home high school will be North.

What about transportation to CEC/North Middle Colleges and CCD? Students who live outside a 3½ mile radius may qualify for an RTD pass.

What career courses are offered at CEC? CEC offers 20 career-oriented classes taught by industry-trained professionals. Many courses offer internships. Please see the brochure.
